

TERRITORY PLANNING PROCESSES ARE FUNCTIONING IMPROPERLY



2 400 number of territory planning documents registered annually

59 % territory planning documents registered with delay of up to **240** working days

Legitimate expectations of interested parties are violated and negative impacts on investments in national development of territories



2020 General plan of the State should be prepared

58 % of information about the status of the General plan provided in information system is inaccurate

General plan of the State should be assessed from economic point of view

CHANGES ARE NEEDED IN THE CONSTRUCTION SECTOR



17 000 construction permits issued annually

7 % issued construction permits are annually declared as illegal by the State Territorial Planning and Construction Inspectorate

19.5 % (22 out of 113 inspected) buildings are actually used not for the purpose indicated in construction permit



18 % arbitrary constructions detected annually

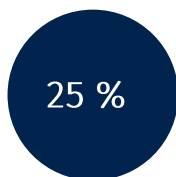
60 court judgements (final) annually obliging to demolish buildings

If construction is declared illegal or buildings are used not for their purpose, damage is suffered by developers, society, environment, and the State

PROBLEMS OF THE RECYCLING OF PRODUCTS AND PACKAGING WASTE ARE NOT ADDRESSED

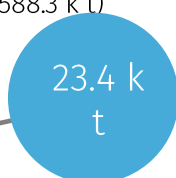
Accurate accounting of products, packaging and waste is necessary

Waste not properly managed (out of 588.3 k t)

Inspected manufacturers and importers do not exercise their duties (do not register in registry, do not declare the imported products and packages)

Manufacturers and importers should have paid for illegally handled waste, however, as of 31-12-2017 pollution charge was not paid

Manufacturers, importers and State bodies may not agree on improperly handled or not handled metal packaging waste (Case of JSC "Metrail")

HAZARDOUS WASTE IS IDENTIFIED, COLLECTED AND HANDLED IMPROPERLY

163 k t hazardous waste produced annually



3.5 M Eur State will have to pay for waste unhandled by **three** waste managers

Conditions created for unequal identification of waste

It is not ensured that unhandled waste is handled not using the State budget funds

FORESTRY SECTOR NEEDS SUSTAINABLE FARMING

- 2018 reform of State forests was launched
- Increase of forests and their resources is not ensured
- There is no balance between conservation of biological diversity and economic benefits of forests
- Insufficient control of the use of Lithuanian forests
