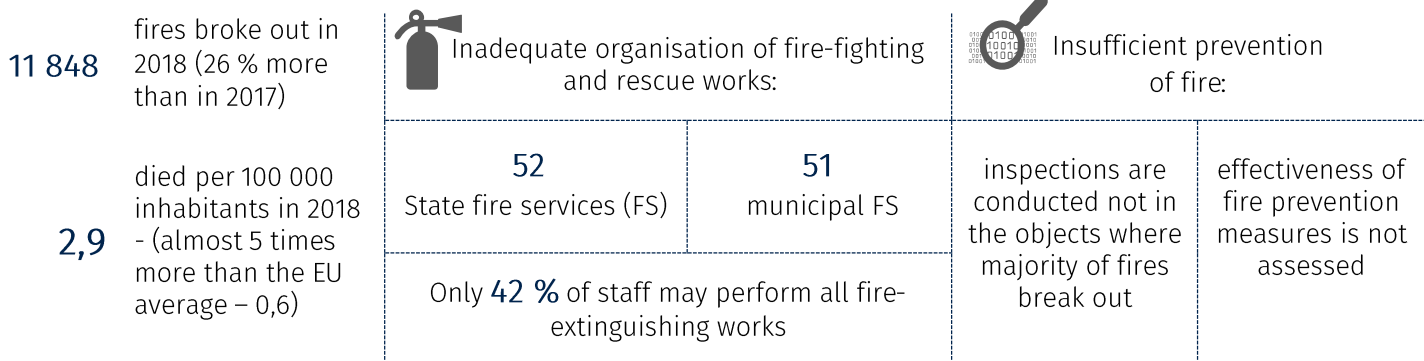


## IMPLEMENTED REFORM OF POLICE ACTIVITIES IMPROVED TIMELY RESPONSE TO INCIDENTS, HOWEVER,

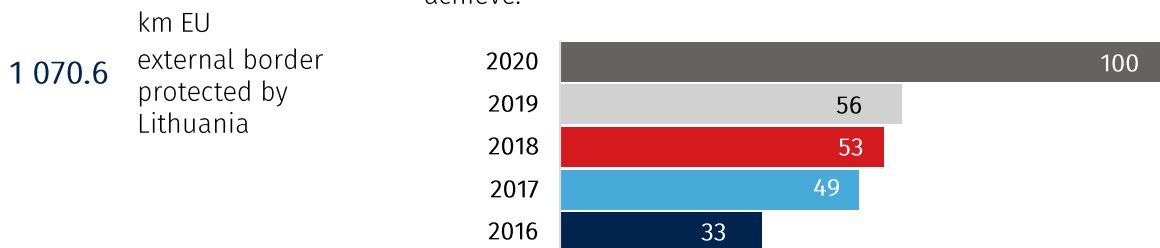
- 57 830 offenses registered in 2018
- Only 52.6 % offenses are investigated due to inadequate organisation of investigation
- 2 065 Offenses per 100 000 inhabitants in 2018 (planned number < 2 000)
- 13.2 % increase in offenses committed by minors due to inconsistent and non-systematic prevention of offenses

## IN 2019 REFORM OF FIRE PREVENTION SYSTEM WAS COMPLETED, HOWEVER,

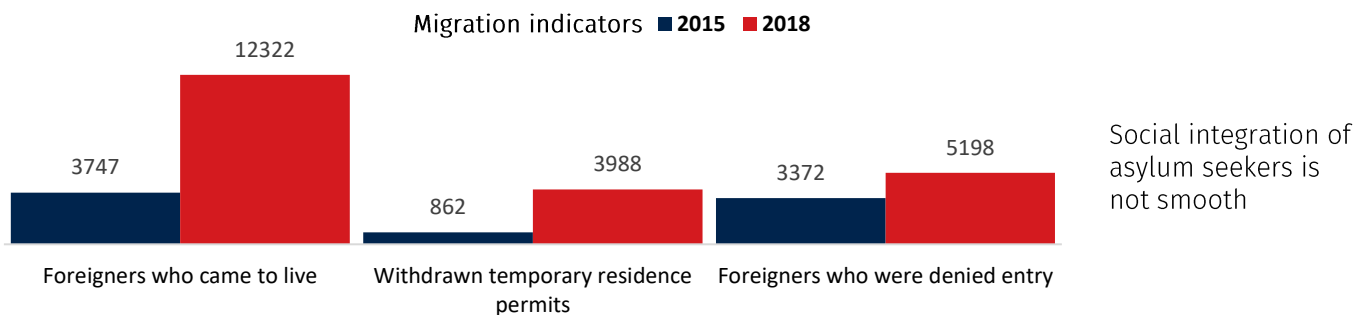


## ONLY PART OF THE EXTERNAL BORDER IS MONITORED USING MODERN TECHNOLOGIES
