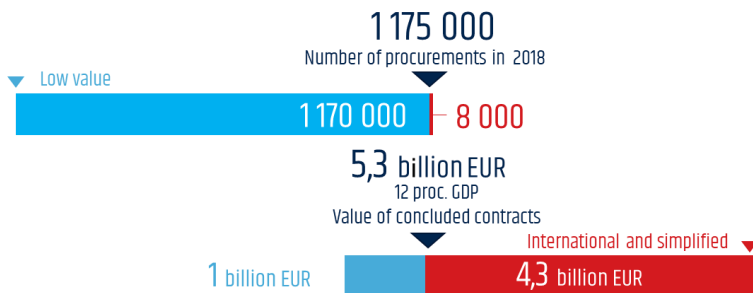


PUBLIC PROCUREMENTS – STRATEGIC TOOL FOR POLICY SHAPING, WHICH LACKS EFFICIENCY

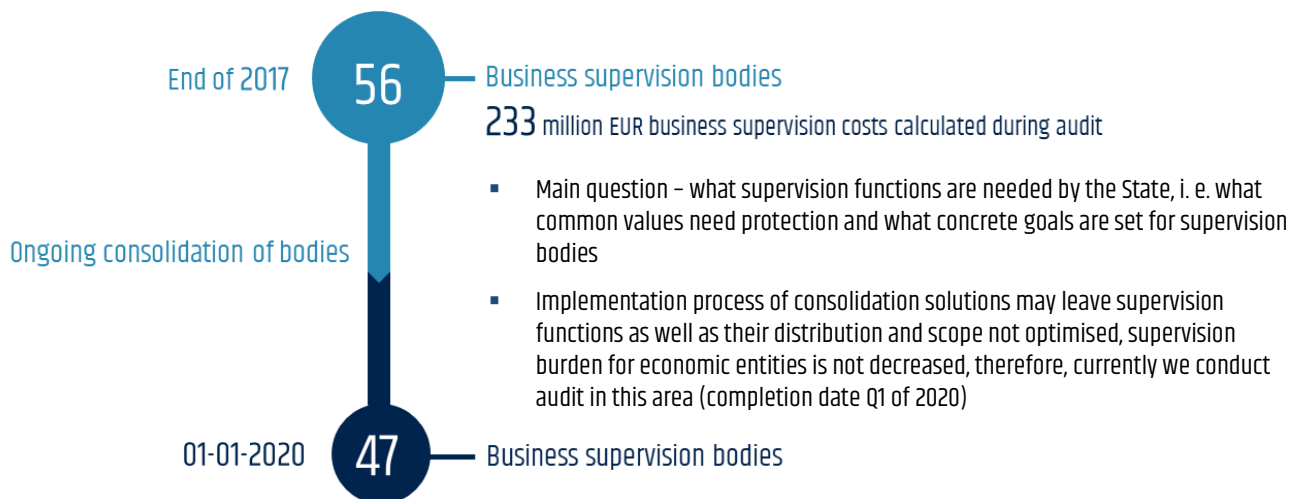


> 4 000 contracting authorities



- EU directives allow to simplify procedures, however, detailed legal regulation of all procurement methods is chosen
- Process-orientation, not result-orientation
- Insufficient use of measures that increase efficiency (centralisation, consolidation, etc.)
- Contracting authorities lack skills and competencies
